Are you ready to welcome a bunny or a pair of bunnies home?

- 1. Rabbits are a 10-12 year commitment.
- 2. While rabbits do not require vaccinations like dogs and cats, they are still considered an "exotic" species which will require you to find a qualified vet. Rabbits should still receive a year check up.
- 3. Is your rabbit for a child? If so, are you ready to assume the responsibility when the novelty wears off?
- 4. Are you able to accept and understand that a rabbit's temperament and behavior is not like that of a cat or dog?
- 5. Can you afford the expenses of food, hay, litter, toys, vet care, and all the other expenses that come with owning a rabbit?
- 6. Will your other pets and those you plan to get in the future get along with your rabbit?
- 7. Are you willing to keep your rabbit no matter how your circumstances change?
